- 1. <u>Call to Order/Roll Call/Agenda Review</u> Meeting convened at 12:33 PM.
- 2. <u>Approve November 14, 2019 Minutes</u> Motion/Second: Yellin/Taylor **Motion passed unanimously.**

- 4. <u>Public Health Emergency Preparedness</u>

Conley outlined County Public Health emergency preparedness priorities which focus on trauma-informed emergency preparedness for individuals requiring additional assistance (IRAA) with special access and functional needs (behavioral, physical, and financial, etc.) during community emergencies (fire, earthquake, tsunami, epidemic, and planned power outages). The County has consulted with the Disability Law Center to ensure that communications are as accessible as possible to persons with disabilities. A healthcare coalition including representatives from local hospitals, clinics, skilled nursing facilities, maternity/surgery centers, and IHSS providers meets monthly to discuss preparedness. Commission will provide a liaison to these meetings. The Commission discussed planned power outages, emergency generators and batteries, cell tower battery back-ups, community resource centers, 2-1-1, and Statewide emergency preparedness drills.

2019 Board of Supervisors meeting approving *Jump Bikes* as the shared-mobility services vendor and directing County staff to ensure that the subsequent contract addresses illegal parking on sidewalks with consequences.
